Headteacher's Notes

Dear parents and carers,

It seems like every week we encounter a new weather challenge – this week, to round off the bitterly cold, wet days we have the presence of Storm Eowyn. Eowyn is here and the forecast predicts a period of very strong and, in places, highly impactful winds crossing the northern half of England. As with any unusual weather, children are naturally curious and it might be a good time to view Eowyn (safely) online with your children and discuss the impact and experiences of such extremes on the local and wider communities. Please be careful if you need to travel!

On Monday, we celebrated Martin Luther King Day – Martin Luther King was an incredibly influential figure who helped to shape America's history. He was a civil rights activist who fought for racial equality. We reflected on his tireless quest for equality. On Tuesday, I shared the story of Ruby Bridges. Ruby made history in 1960 when, at the age of six, she became the first black student to attend an all-white school in New Orleans. Our children were appalled at her treatment and inspired by her bravery. They understand why Ruby was a symbol of the vulnerability of all black Americans.

Thank you to our families who have embraced our walk to school initiative. If you live too far from school to walk all the way, Park and Stride is the perfect solution. Simply Park your car at least 10 minutes away from school, then finish the journey on foot, by bike, or scooter – and it still counts as an active travel day! We have two great 'Park and Stride' locations to choose from: Sherdley Park Driving Range Car Park – just a 10-minute walk to school and Morrisons, who are kindly supporting our initiative, on Baxters Lane – this location offers a 15-minute walk to school. Every active journey helps our pupils earn badges and makes a big difference to our school community and the planet!

Further to our recent Facebook post, I would like to extend the local authority's invite to families and young people with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) to attend a special **SEND Information Day** on **Tuesday, 28th January 2025**, at the **Totally Wicked Stadium**. This exciting event provides a valuable opportunity to meet local service providers, to explore the support and resources available, and learn about the wide range of services tailored to young people with SEND. The event will feature **two drop-in sessions** to accommodate different schedules: an **Afternoon Session: 10am - 2pm** and an **Early Evening Session: 5pm - 7:30pm**.
