They learned about how Jewish ceremonies are run within the Synagogue and discovered interesting facts - for example - Did you know that there is always a light on in a Synagogue that is never turned off. After the Synagogue, the Year 2 children went over to Crosby beach where they got to explore the environment and see the Anthony Gormley statues. This linked to the children's last art unit when they made figures out of clay. The children sketched their surroundings.
