Headteacher's Notes

Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had a sunshine filled rather hot week at Robins Lane. Despite having windows open and wearing fewer clothes, the heat has at times, been a real challenge. The children and staff have really persevered to not allow the difficult conditions to impact on teaching and learning. Thank you for your support.

This week, in our Tuesday inspiration assembly, I shared the amazing life story of Christopher Reeve. The children were familiar with the Superhero 'Superman' Clarke Kent character played by Christopher Reeve but weren't so knowledgeable about Reeve's real life heroic actions. They were sad to hear that Christopher Reeve had been paralysed in a riding accident when he was 43 years old. His life changed immeasurably. Christopher did not give up in despite his life changing injury. He breathed with the aid of a ventilator as he campaigned tirelessly for better research and facilities for paralysed people and his foundation raised over \$100 million dollars to support his cause. He was a true real-life Superman. What an inspiration.

On Tuesday, Year 4 enjoyed an exciting experience day at the Totally Wicked Stadium, where they took part in team-building and communication activities. They explored healthy lifestyle choices by discussing the Eatwell Guide, comparing healthy snacks to treats, and learning about the effects of sugary drinks. The day also included a look at the heritage of Saints through historical items such as old rugby balls, kits, and footwear. To finish the day, the children showcased their rugby skills and even got to try on Saints' kits! Thank you to Mrs Matthews for organising this visit.
